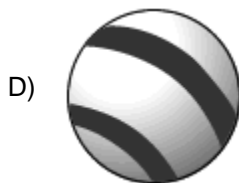

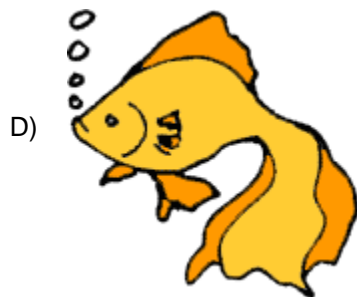
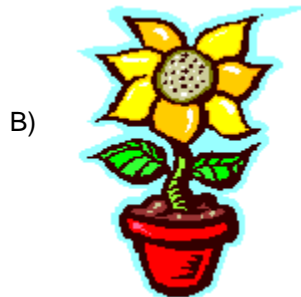

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Instructions for Teacher-Read Offline Assessments

Teacher Instructions:

This test packet includes:

- 1) test booklets
- 2) student answer sheets containing student and test identification information

As soon as you receive your test material, confirm that you have enough testing materials for each student in your class.

You may provide students with scratch paper or students may write in the test booklet.

Allow a few minutes at the beginning of the testing period to review the assessment instructions with students. Start by reading the directions on the cover page aloud to the students.

As you begin to administer the assessment, remember to follow the teacher directions accompanying the item. Each question may be read up to but not exceeding three times. Teachers may not interpret nor describe any graphic images. Do not answer questions related to the content of the test itself. This includes translating, rephrasing, or adding information to the test question, answers, or related content.

Once the assessment period is over, collect the students' test booklets and answer sheets. Provide to assigned district staff the answer sheets for scanning and the test booklets for proper disposal.
