



Acceptable Use Policy

Introduction

The Fruchthendler community has the privilege of using technology at our school to enhance our learning, expand our thinking, and express our ideas. With every privilege comes responsibility. It is our responsibility to use technology appropriately by following acceptable use guidelines.

These guidelines help direct us in making good decisions and protect us, so we can have a safe, enjoyable experience using all types of technology. By following these guidelines we show respect for ourselves and others.

Netiquette:

You are expected to abide by the generally accepted rules of netiquette. These include, but are not limited to the following:

As a Student:

I will:

- use the computer as it pertains to my assignments.
- follow all school rules.
- follow copyright laws and give credit where necessary.
- use appropriate language at all times.
- notify teacher of inappropriate material I encounter immediately.

I will not:

- give out personal information including full name, address, phone number, and passwords.
- use personal e-mail or instant messaging in class.
- insult, harass, or attack others in any way.

As a teacher:

- I will provide students with the necessary rules and procedures for using the Internet.
- I will remind students of proper netiquette.
- I will monitor and supervise students during computer use.
- I will not publish student information or photos on the web without the proper permission given below.

As a parent:

- I agree to discuss these rules, guidelines, and consequences with my child.
- I understand that filters are in place to protect my child from harmful information and will not hold the school and its staff responsible for controversial materials acquired on the network.
- I understand that my child's work may be featured on the web. No personal information will be shared. In the event that my child's work is displayed on the web,
- I understand that the school will follow the TUSD policy for web publication as follows:

Web sites should follow the [Guidelines for Student Rights and Responsibilities](#), and reflect professionalism as defined in the [TUSD-TEA Consensus Agreement](#). Web sites should not be used for commercial or personal gain. School sponsored activities and fund raising efforts may be announced. Laws of privacy for students should be respected on the Web. Photographs of students or staff should be used only with permission for the parent or staff member. Students' last names should not be used on Web Sites. Any information posted on Web Sites representing TUSD must conform to TUSD Acceptable Use of Technology Resources Policy Code: EJA through the Technology and Telecommunication Services Department.
