Dear Parents/Guardians:

This year, Sahuaro High School will be offering summer school from May 28th – June 30th. Classes run Monday through Friday from 7am until 12:30pm. The cost is \$100 per semester or \$180 for a full year credit of the same course. During this time, it is possible for a student to make up for lost credit, improve a passing grade, or advance in credits by attending one or both semesters of summer school.

Reasons for your child to take summer school:

- **Failed a course:** Since students must have all of the required credits to graduate on time, it may be beneficial for students who have failed a course to enroll in our summer school program.
- **Improve a passing grade:** A student can retake a course in an attempt to receive a higher passing grade. Although an additional credit towards graduation is not earned, the higher grade would replace the lower grade in the calculation of the grade point average.
- **Advance in credits:** Courses taken in summer school may allow students to get ahead in credits or to take other classes, such as electives, that would not fit in their schedule during the normal school year.

For families that cannot pay the full amount at the time of registration, a deposit of 1/3 the cost of tuition plus a \$10 nonrefundable registration fee can be accepted to hold your son/daughter's place in the class; however, payment must be paid in full by Friday May 22nd to meet contractual obligations to the teachers. Scholarships based on financial need may be available – please contact your son/daughter's counselor for more information.

On the back of this letter, you will find a flyer that will give you a list of the course offerings for both semesters. There are a limited number of seats in summer school so you may want to enroll your student as early as possible. If you are interested in enrolling your student, please have your child pick up the registration papers in the counselor's office. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me at 731-7207. If you need information regarding what course your child should take, please contact the appropriate counselor assigned by alpha.
