

Parents,

Here is an update to the opportunities for scholarships for our students to attend summer school and I'm hoping to get your help in letting our students know. I have received additional funds and can now offer a few scholarships to our current freshmen who need to take summer school for credit recovery. Below is a summary...

- Freshmen, sophomores, and juniors who need to take summer school for credit recovery are eligible for a scholarship (1st attachment). And yes, this information has changed – I just received more funds yesterday and can now include freshmen! The cost to attend would be only \$45 regardless if they attend a semester or the full year. The \$45 is nonrefundable. Please note that they must have their counselor sign the form towards the bottom of the page to confirm they are eligible. There are a limited number of scholarships available (200 full year) and they are first come, first served. Students would bring the application with them to a registration signup along with the other summer school forms (located in the counseling office).
- Students who qualify for free/reduced lunch, receive DES or Social Security assistance, live in a group or foster home, or qualify for AHCCS may qualify for a scholarship (2nd attachment). Students in these categories would receive partial scholarships (free/reduced lunch, DES or SSI) or full (homeless, group home, etc). But again, there are a limited number of scholarships available and they are first come, first served. This application must be turned in prior to registration so I can determine a budget based on the application.
- The first 125 incoming freshmen who register for Freshman Academy will receive a partial scholarship. The cost to attend will be reduced to \$45 and students will receive an elective credit towards graduation. No application is required to receive this scholarship but verification that the student is pre-enrolled here at Sahuaro will be conducted.

If a student doesn't qualify for a scholarship but cannot pay the full amount at the time of registration, please let them know that we will also accept payment plans. For families that cannot pay the full amount at the time of registration, a deposit of 1/3 the cost of tuition plus a \$10 nonrefundable registration fee (or \$40/semester) can be accepted to hold the student's place in the class; however, payment must be paid in full by Friday May 21st to meet contractual obligations to the teachers. Thank you for sharing the information with our students so they are aware of their choices. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask.
