New Business

- **Principal's report-Bonn**
 - Coach Heavner-Bonn and Heavner
 - Introduce Chris Heavner –Coach Heavner discussed his different phases in preparing for the new football season. Phase 1 is strength and conditioning, working on academics. He will conduct a renovation in the basement of the gym, he is looking for help. The room will be a study hall for students, which will be alternating between weight training and studying. Goal will be to give students I (incompletes) instead of Fs, and to start grading for mastery not the homework. Hope is that the common core will help move students towards mastery.

 - New High School Superintendent aspires to growing capacity in our leadership, developing our own.
- Funding-Bonn
 - No funding for CTE next year, Econ and Health as one block in freshmen year, try to get students in fun classes as freshmen to get them to buy into school.
- Bonnie Worhtman-Bonn
 - Acheivement and equalization of African American and Hispanic, to help increase of AP enrollment and students taking college level classes.
- Security-Bonn
 - Decrease of incidents on campus by 3% this year, there are 2.2 million square feet here with only 2 monitors, there is a need for more monitors
- Dell Computers-Bonn
 - First high school to get computers from the lease agreement with Dell, they will fix the computers, all teachers are getting a lap top, next year SRHS will be the on of the first schools to get WiFi on fampus.

 - SRHS will have two student advisors to help do assessments here on this campus.
