Math

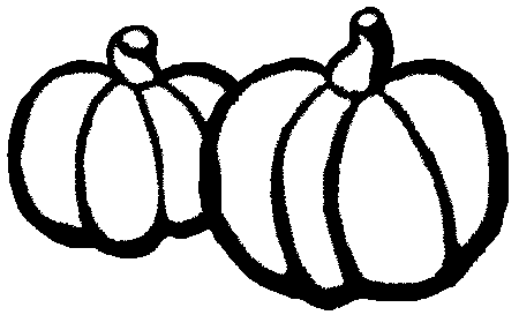
We will continue a unit on money. The students will identify the value of quarters, dimes, nickels, pennies, and dollar bills in a variety of combinations.
