

## Important Dates for University High Admissions 2011-2012

**Fall 2011 – Incoming Freshman Admissions cycle for 8<sup>th</sup> graders only. The admission cycle for sophomore, juniors and seniors does not begin until April 2012.**

Dates and deadlines are important to follow to the greatest extent because it will allow for a smoother and faster admissions process. Families are encouraged to review the UHS Admissions Policy on the web-site to fully understand the admissions criteria.

August 2011	Application submission begins
September 23 <sup>rd</sup> :	Application Deadline for Incoming Freshman Applications
October – November	Students enrolled in TUSD Middle Schools will be tested at their sites. Only students who have submitted an application by September 23 <sup>rd</sup> will be tested.
October 14 <sup>th</sup> :	Testing for Non-TUSD enrolled students - only students who have submitted an application will be tested. Testing will be held in the UHS cafeteria. Students are asked to arrive at 8:30 for check-in.
December 7 <sup>th</sup> :	Last day to submit a late application for Incoming freshman. No additional applicants will be accepted for freshman placement at this time and no other test dates are currently planned.
December 19 <sup>th</sup> :	Testing for absent or late applicants. Students must have submitted an application by deadline. Testing will be held in the UHS cafeteria. Students are asked to arrive at 8:30 for check-in.
December 17 <sup>th</sup> :	Students who do not meet the required minimum score on the test will be officially notified by mail.  Non-TUSD students who meet the required minimum score will be notified by email, requesting report cards/transcript information and birth certificate. If no email is provided, families will be notified by phone. Deadline for submission of this information is January 14 <sup>th</sup> .
January 3 <sup>rd</sup> 2012	TUSD students who meet the UHS admission criteria (test and GPA) will be officially notified by mail.
January 17 <sup>th</sup> :	Non-TUSD students who have submitted report cards/transcripts will be officially notified by mail as to their admissions status.

Students who receive official notification of acceptance will be able to set up visits/shadowing at UHS if necessary. A school orientation will also be scheduled during this time

February 17<sup>th</sup>: Deadline for submitting acceptance/decline offer.

Whether accepting or declining placement, returning the placement letter greatly assists UHS in preparing for freshman year and triggers several important processes. If space availability becomes an issue, students who have not returned their statements within the appropriate time-frame may not be able to be accommodated.
